

# **Del Norte LOV Foundation** Scholarship Program LOV Foundation Associated With Del Norte Credit Union

# THE PROGRAM

Del Norte LOV Foundation associated with Del Norte Credit Union (DNCU) has established a scholarship program to assist Del Norte Credit Union members who are high school seniors, homeschool seniors, or GED\* recipients who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited institution of the student's choice.

This scholarship program is administered by Scholarship America<sup>®</sup>, the nation's largest designer and manager of scholarship and tuition reimbursement programs for corporations, foundations, associations, and individuals. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, age, gender, disability, or national origin.

\* GED must be received in the same year enrolled in higher education courses.

# **ELIGIBILITY**

Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- Be a member of Del Norte Credit Union (DNCU) prior to the application deadline
- Be a high school senior, equivalent home-school senior, or a recipient of a GED received in same year of higher education enrollment
- Plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocationaltechnical school for the entire upcoming academic year
- Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (or its equivalent)

#### **AWARDS**

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a one-time award of \$1,000. Up to ten (10) awards will be granted.

- Five awards will be granted to students from the following selected high schools. One award per school will be granted, assuming there are sufficient qualified applicants:
  - Los Alamos High School, Los Alamos, NM
  - Santa Fe High School, Santa Fe, NM
  - · Capital High School, Santa Fe, NM
- Pojoaque Valley High School, Pojoaque, NM
- Española Valley High School, Española, NM
- Five awards will be granted from all other applicants. Two of the five awards will be granted to applicants from other high schools in the communities DNCU serves. One will be for a home-school student. Two will be for applicants receiving their GEDs. If no applications are received from the latter two groups, additional scholarships will go to other high school applicants in the DNCU service area.

Awards are for undergraduate study only.

### **APPLICATION**

Credit Union members interested in a scholarship may obtain an application from the Del Norte Credit Union website, dncu.com. All interested students must complete the application and mail it, along with a current, complete transcript of grades, to Scholarship America postmarked no later than March 26, 2021. Grade reports are not acceptable. Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and the term in which each course was taken.

Applicants will receive acknowledgment of receipt of their application. If an acknowledgment is not received within three weeks, applicants may call Scholarship America to verify that the application has been received.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated.

All applications received are considered confidential and are reviewed only by Scholarship America. Although not considered in the selection process, applicants are required to attach an essay that will be sent to Del Norte LOV Foundation and DNCU for possible promotional purposes.

#### **SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS**

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal. Submitted essays are required but are not part of the selection process. Financial need is not considered.

Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship America. In no instance does any officer or employee of the Del Norte LOV Foundation or DNCU play a part in the selection. All applicants agree to accept the decision as final.

Applicants will be notified in mid-May. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

# **PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS**

Scholarship America processes scholarship payments on behalf of the Del Norte LOV Foundation associated with DNCU in early August. Checks are mailed to each recipient's home address and are made payable to the school for the student.

#### **OBLIGATIONS**

Recipients have no obligation to Del Norte LOV Foundation and DNCU. They are, however, required to notify Scholarship America of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete, current transcript when requested.

# **REVISIONS**

Del Norte LOV Foundation and DNCU reserve the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time, including termination of the program.
